

Report on the Kingsford Car Park Consultation

To gauge community attitudes on the proposed Kingsford roundabout car park as part of the light rail project, Randwick City Council ran an on-line survey through the dedicated consultation website: www.yoursayrandwick.com.au/lightrail

The survey was promoted through:

- Your say Randwick database newsletter
- Randwick Community News newsletter
- Randwick eNews articles
- Facebook postings
- Twitter
- Advertising in the Southern Courier
- Media releases
- Notification to chambers and precincts

Over the period 2 May to 25 July 2014, 303 residents responded and chose to complete the survey.

The survey asked three key questions:

- 1) On a scale of 1-5, how easy is it at the moment to find parking in the Kingsford area?
- 2) Please rate on a scale of 1-5 how important it is to you to provide parking in the Kingsford area?
- 3) Should Council consider acquiring land near the Kingsford roundabout to build a multi-storey car park?

The results show:

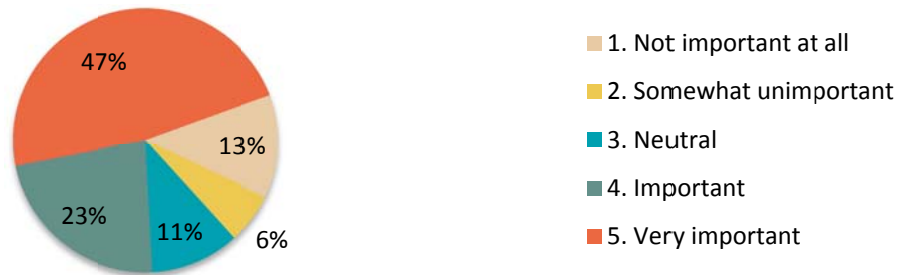
1. That 62% of respondents currently find it very difficult or somewhat difficult to find car parking in Kingsford.

1) On a scale of 1-5, how easy is it at the moment to find parking in the Kingsford area?



2. That 70% of respondents thought that providing car parking in the Kingsford was important or very important.

2) Please rate on a scale of 1-5 how important it is to you to provide parking in the Kingsford area?



3. That 68% of respondents said that Council should acquire land in the Kingsford area to build a multi-story car park.
