- ➔ **road upgrades for Astoria Circuit and Yorktown Parade**
- ➔ new footpaths for Anzac Parade, Gale Road, Garden Street, Haig Street, Maroubra Road and Tyrwhitt Street

Reusing stormwater

\$280,000 to install a stormwater harvesting system to irrigate the parks around Maroubra Beach and replace the irrigation system at Snape Park.

Coastal Walkway works

\$800,000 to continue the Coastal Walkway upgrade with proposed construction through golf courses and Malabar Headland, and \$1.4 million for new toilets and change rooms at Mahon Pool, right near the new extension to the Coastal Walkway.



Record spend on roads and footpaths

\$10 million towards roads construction and improvements across Randwick City, including \$1.7 million allocated to building and upgrading footpaths, and \$250,000 for new cycling facilities.
