Record spend on roads and footpaths:

\$10 million towards roads construction and improvements across Randwick City, including \$1.7 million allocated to building and upgrading footpaths, \$300,000 to upgrade the eastern footpath of Belmore Road, from Alison Road to opposite Silver Street, and \$250,000 for new cycling facilities.



Develop a business continuity plan:

\$100,000 to develop a business continuity plan for those businesses possibly impacted by the introduction of light rail.
