Requirements: Attend meetings quarterly

Randwick City Council is calling for expressions of interest for five (5) local residents and three (3) business representatives to join Council's Community Light Rail Support Plan Committee. The Committee will meet regularly to discuss how best to implement Council's light rail support plan which is designed to reduce the impact of light rail on local residents and businesses.

This is a voluntary role designed to help facilitate discussion between the Council and the community and provide objective and constructive feedback on how to best implement Council's support plan.

In addition to the five resident members and three business representatives, the committee will also include a Council representative, a cycling industry representative and a representative from Souths Juniors.

The resident and business committee members will be drawn at random from a pool of interested people who best meet Council's selection criteria and are able to provide constructive advice on implementing the light rail support plan.

To be considered as one of the five (5) resident committee members, you need to:

- live within Randwick City
- be available to attend after hours meetings and undertake additional work or community discussions as the need arises
- demonstrate an understanding of Council's light rail support plan
- demonstrate a commitment to giving Council objective and constructive feedback on the implementation of the Light Rail Support Plan rather than a debate on broader public transport issues
- have relevant experience working with community organisations
- have a knowledge of the local area
- be able to work cooperatively with others of different opinions and backgrounds

To be considered as one of the three (3) business committee members, you need to:

- own, lease or work in a business in Randwick City
- be available to attend after hours meetings and undertake additional work or community discussions as the need arises
- demonstrate an understanding of Council's light rail support plan
- demonstrate a commitment to giving Council objective and constructive feedback on the implementation of the Light Rail Support Plan rather than a debate on broader public transport issues
- have a knowledge of the local area
- have relevant experience working cooperatively with other local businesses
